June 15, 2011 \$1000	Royal Canadian Legion	Available to a graduating student who is pursuing post-secondary studies who has a parent or grandparent who is/was a member of the Canadian Armed Forces.
June 3, 2011 \$500	WASWC Scholarship	Available to a graduating student pursuing post-secondary studies in scientific or environmental fields.
May 31, 2011 + \$900	Peter B. Mayes Scholarship	Presented to a student who is continuing their post-secondary education in the area of the trades.
